LOADING DOCKS/ FREIGHT ELEVATORS

Four-bay loading dock on Wabash Avenue. All cars support a maximum capacity of 20,000 lbs.

BAY 1:

- Serviced by Car #28. Access from Wabash Avenue. Dimensions of fold-down metal door is 12'H x 15'5"W. This car serves all four Salons in the Stevens Meeting center.

BAY 2:

- Serviced by Car #25 and additional service elevators. Access from Wabash Avenue. Dimensions of roll-down metal doors are 11'9"H x 12'4"W and 12'H x 12'5"W. Height of staging areas is 3'4". This car serves the Grand Ballroom, International Ballroom, and Stevens Salon C.

BAY 3:

- Serviced by Car #25 and additional service elevators. Access from Wabash Avenue. Dimensions of roll-down metal doors are 11'9"H x 12'4"W and 12'H x 12'5"W. Height of staging areas is 3'4". This car serves the Grand Ballroom, International Ballroom, and Stevens Salon C.

BAY 5:

- Serviced by Car #27. Sidewalk access from Wabash Avenue. Freight car is located south of main loading dock area. Interior dimensions of car are: 27'3"L x 11'10"W x 9'10"H. Dimensions of doors are 9'10"H x 12'W. This car serves the Continental Room and Stevens Salons A, C, and D.

PERMANENT SCREENS

- International Ballroom — (3) 20' x 18' electric screens centered on west wall
- Grand Ballroom — 20' x 20' electric screen centered on east wall
- McCormick Board Room — 8' x 8' electric screen centered on south wall
- Pullman Board Room — 8' x 8' electric screen centered on south wall

DANCE FLOORS

- Portable dance floors can be set in any desired room.

Each section measures 4' x 4'.

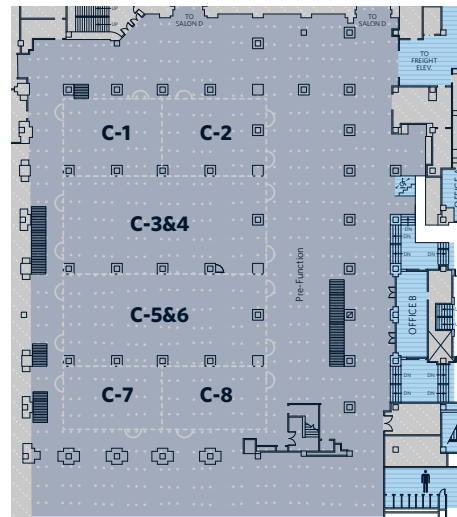
Salon C, Layout Option 1



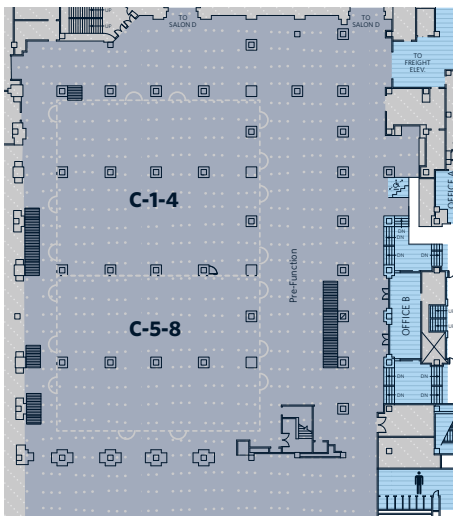
Salon C, Layout Option 4



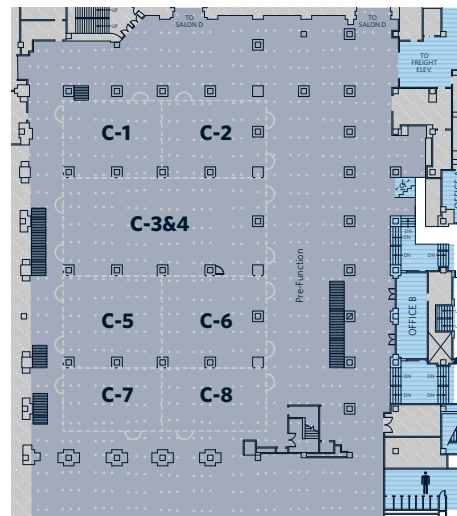

1946 - Hilton Hotels Corporation is formed and Hilton Chicago becomes the corporate headquarters.

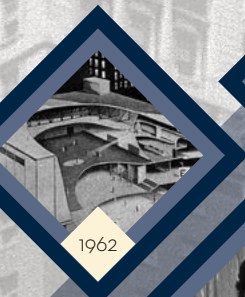

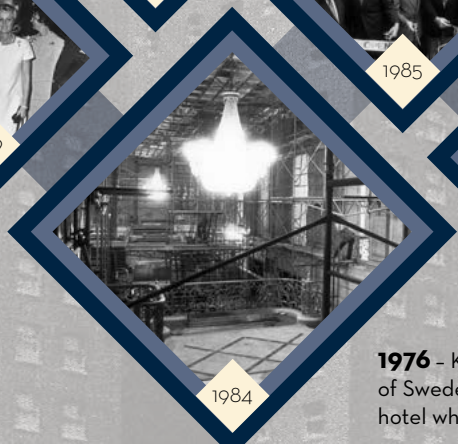
